Dear Parent/ Guardian:

On Tuesday, **February 28th and March 7th**, we are planning an *optional* ski day for grade 7, 8 & 9 students. Students can opt into one day or both days of skiing. Castle Mountain has offered an excellent rate for our students and we have done our best to keep costs (i.e. transportation) as reasonable as possible. We certainly do not want funding to be a barrier to participation, so as always, please call the office if you need assistance in this manner. Kidsport here in Claresholm is also *another* avenue for assistance.

A lesson is **mandatory** for all students regardless of their ability level. It is our feeling that everyone benefits from instruction and our jurisdiction insurance coverage **requires lessons** for all. All students **MUST wear an approved ski/snowboard helmet** for the duration of the day. Students who do not own a helmet will be expected to rent one from the resort. Due to the insurance coverage restrictions of the School Board, students are **NOT allowed to ski or board in the terrain parks** at the hill.

Students will be leaving the school at 6:45 a.m. (arrive at the school by 6:30 a.m. please) and return to the school by 6:00 p.m. Bussing will be provided for all students. Students **MUST** travel to and from the school via the buses provided. If a parent is picking up their child(ren) from the ski hill, they must advise a supervisor and attend to the necessary paperwork **before** they leave the hill. **Parents may only provide transportation for their own child.**

Here are a few information items to be aware of:

- Students are responsible for their own lunch at the hill. A full service cafeteria is available, though costly. A bag lunch is recommended.
- Students are advised NOT to bring large amounts of money or valuables to the ski hill
- Student equipment will be transported to and from the hill via a separate truck.
- Students need to be dressed appropriately: warm winter jacket, snow pants, warm, water-proof mitts or gloves (not knitted). No scarves please!
- Students **MUST** ski/ snowboard within the ski area boundaries at all times and to follow the resort's Code of Conduct.

Students who wish to participate in this field trip must complete the attached payment form and consent form, with payment. The first payment to the school by Friday, **February 15th 2017**. The payment deadline for the second day is **February 27th, 2017**. Cheques are to be made **payable to WCCHS**.
